- Create an account with Canva: a free online graphic design software platform,

- Identity fundamental design elements,
- Create your own designs using Canva such as: Instagram post, Facebook post, Twitter post, Poster, Logo, Brochure, Magazine cover, Business card, Flyer, Postcard, Invitation

What will I study?

- Creating and setting up your account.
- Navigation around Canva's interface.
- Selecting pre-made layouts and templates.
- Adding artwork, images, text, and backgrounds.
- Downloading your designs.

Assessment method

You will be assessed using various assessment methods, including individual digital assessment of your understanding and group work.

Entry requirements

You will need a suitable device to connect to Microsoft Teams to participate in an online session. No prior knowledge of Canva or graphic design theory are needed as Canva provides free templates and graphics to use.

You will need to take notes so make sure you have your preferred tools in easy reach, such as pen/paper or electronic device.
