# Carework – Level E3 Certificate in Health and Care

#### **Course overview**



The course aims to provide learners with knowledge and understanding and an introduction to the skills required in health and Care to support progression to employment to an apprenticeship or to further study at a higher level.

- Persona Centered support in Heal, Social care and Childrens and Young people's settings.
- Dementia Awareness
- Healthy Eating and Drinking for Adults
- Infection Prevention and Control

# Assessment method

Throughout the course you will receive feedback from your tutor. You will be assessed using various assessment methods, including your portfolio of evidence (which will be assessed by the accrediting organisation, on-line and paper-based assessments, individual and group work. You will also learn the skills to self reflect and evaluate your progress.
