Carework – Level 3 Certificate in Preparing to Work in Adult Social Care



Course overview

This is a progression course. You must have completed the L2 Certificate in preparing to work in Adult Social Care.

The course aims to provide learners with further knowledge, understanding and skills required to work in an unsupervised capacity in health and Care to support progression to employment to an apprenticeship or to further study at a higher level.

This course is a progression course and builds upon the knowledge and skills from the previous level.

There are a huge number of employment opportunities within Adult Social Care and this course could be the start of a new career.

This is a must have for anyone taking the adult Advanced Health and Social Care apprenticeship

This course is a blended delivery course, which means that some sessions will be face to face and other will be delivered online. Full details of which sessions are online, will be provided by tutor, once course starts.

Who is it for?

Assessment method

Throughout the course you will receive feedback from your tutor. You will be assessed using various assessment methods, including your e- portfolio of evidence (which will be assessed by the accrediting organisation, on-line and paper-based assessments, individual and group work. You will also learn the skills to self reflect and evaluate your progress.

Entry requirements

Successful completion of Level 2 qualification in health and social care or related subject.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen and paper or an electronic device.

Key information

This is a blended delivery course, with some sessions held onsite, with others as an online delivery mode.

Where possible this course will take place on site with social distancing measures in place.

In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

You will also have the opportunity to enrol onto a minimum of 2 enrichment courses, which will help further develop your skills and knowledge.
