What will I study?

You will:

- The roles and responsibilities of working in Childcare
- The types of Jobs & careers opportunities within the Childcare industry
- Be Assessed on your current levels in functional skills
- · Be informed of your progression routes

Assessment method

You will complete an online assessment of your functional skills. Teachers will also assess your communication and written skills, through verbal and written assignments and tasks.

No previous experience required but ideally you will need a good level of communication in English.
