

Childcare: Entry Level Award in Childcare (E3)

Course overview

This course is suitable for anyone who wants to gain more of an understanding about caring for children or working in a setting, including those with special educational needs or where English is an additional language.

This qualification is designed to stimulate and encourage your understanding of the skills required to care for children. They support the learner in preparing for the "next steps" either in training or moving towards the world of work and will reflect the themes of Every Child Matters and Early Years Foundation.

What will I study?

You will:

- Working in Early Years Settings
- Communicating with Children
- Option of additional units, if appropriate

Assessment method

You will receive verbal and written feedback from your tutor for classroom activities, course work, assignments and home study. You will be required to create a portfolio of evidence, which will be assessed by the accrediting association.

Entry requirements

You must have attended and fully completed Childcare or Care work introduction.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to provide notepad & pen or your chosen method of note-taking – you will also need to provide an A4 ring binder to collate your evidence for your portfolio.
