

Level 1 Award in Preparing to Work in Schools

Course overview

This is an ideal progression route for those not quite ready for the full Teaching Assistant qualification. You may already be supporting children and young people in a school environment, but you don't have to be employed or volunteering for this knowledge-based qualification. After successful completion of the introduction, you can now focus your time on improving the skills you need to progress to the full Level 2 certificate.

What will I study?

- child and young person development
- safeguarding the welfare of young people
- communication and professional relationships
- equality, diversity and inclusion
- schools as organisations

Assessment method

You will receive verbal and written feedback from your tutor for classroom activities, course work and home study. Your portfolio will also be assessed by the accrediting organisation.

Entry requirements

You will have successfully completed the Introduction to Teaching Assistant, Health & Social Care or Childcare as well as online English, maths and ICT assessments.
