TA – Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning (TOP UP)



Course overview

This course is specifically for those learners who were impacted by Covid 19 and were not able to fully complete their certificate owing to schools being closed and learners unable to complete their work placement element of their level 2.

This is open only by invite only – learners will be contacted to enrol.

You must have secured a placement in order to complete this qualification.

It is aimed at learners working in roles that support pupils' learning in primary, secondary, or special schools, as well as colleges.

During your placement you will be working under close supervision of the class teacher whose lesson planning and day to day direction sets the framework within which the individual works or within which you will be working.

What will I study?

- Safeguarding children and young people
- Equality, diversity and inclusion in a learning environment for children and young people
- Maintain relationships with children and young people
- Support the health and safety of children and young people
- Support positive behaviour in a learning environment for children and young people
- Contribute to teamwork in a learning environment
- Promote an effective learning environment
- Provide displays in a learning environment
- Employability skills

You will also be encouraged to attend a minimum of 2 of our enrichment courses, which will further help you to develop your skills, knowledge and behaviours, supporting this qualification.

Assessment method

• You will be assessed using a wide range of methods, which will include written assignments, displays, presentations and obsevations. You will create an e-portfolio, in which you will keep your evidence, this portofolio will be assessed by our Internal Quality Assurer and the External Quality Assurer from the awarding body.

Entry requirements

Your must have completed L2 Award in Supporting Teaching and learning or have completed all knowledge units of the L2 Certificate in supporting teaching and learning.

You will be invited onto the course prior to enrolment – it is not an open enrolment. Only learners affected by Covid 19 who were enrolled onto L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning and who fully completed their knowledge units will be eligible to enrol onto this course.

You **must** have a work placement within a school, which can be either voluntary or paid in order to complete this course. Written confirmation of your placement will need to be provided.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to provide notepad & pen or your chosen method of notetaking and an A4 Lever Arch file.

Key information

This course is a blended delivery course, which means you will have some face to face and some online remote delivery. Where possible this course will take place on site with social distancing measures in place.

In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.
