TA – Level 4 Certificate in Supporting the learning of Learners with Special Education Needs & Disability (SEND)



Course overview

This is a progression course.

The qualification extends the skills of those involved in providing support to learners with SEND, in order to improve their own practice and help develop that of their colleagues.

Learners enrolling onto this course must have interactions with learners with SEND, to enable them to evidence the skills elements of the qualification.

What will I study?

- Understand the Four Broad Areas of Special Education need
- Using Evidence based Practice with Leaners with Special Education needs and Disability
- Communication skills for professional supporting the learning of those with Special Education needs and Disability
- Person Centred Approaches with Learners with Special Education needs and Disability
- Coaching Skills
- Developing the Metacognitive Skills of Learners with Special Education Needs and Disability
- Action Research
- Employability skills

You will also be encouraged to attend a minimum of 2 of our enrichment courses, which will further help you to develop your skills, knowledge and behaviours, supporting this qualification.

Assessment method

You will be assessed using a wide range of methods, which will include written assignments, displays, presentations and
obsevations. You will create an e-portfolio, in which you will keep your evidence, this portofolio will be assessed by our Internal
Quality Assurer and the External Quality Assurer from the awarding body.

Entry requirements

In order to enter for this qualification, learners must have considerable experience of supporting the learning of learners with SEND and be working in a role where they will be able to put into practice the skills that they are required to evidence for the qualification. You will have successfully completed and attained Level 3 Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning. You will be working at level 2 English and Maths or have attained functional skills at Level 2. You **must** have a work placement within a school, which can be either voluntary or paid to complete this course. Written confirmation of your placement will need to be provided.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to provide notepad & pen or your chosen method of notetaking and an A4 Lever Arch file.

Key information

This course is being delivered by a blended method, which means that you will have some face-to-face delivery but the majority will be done via online delivery via teams.

When sessions are delivery onsite, full social distancing measures will be in place.

In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.
