

Level 3 Education and Training

Course overview

This is an introductory teaching qualification that replaces what used to be known as Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector (PTLLS). It is suitable for trainers in the private sector or those looking at Further Education colleges and the post 16 sector and is your first step into Education and Training within Adult Education & Further Education.

The course is designed for those who are not currently in a teaching, training, or support role but would like to enter the profession as well as those who might already be delivering some training and would like to obtain a nationally recognised qualification.

The course attracts applicants from a variety of sectors including the hair and beauty industry, NHS, building environment, local government trainers, and others. This makes for a varied classroom that is interesting as you hear how fellow learners apply the same core techniques to their various sectors and makes for interesting diverse micro teaches.

What will I study?

- Understanding roles, responsibilities and relationships in education and training
- Understanding and using inclusive teaching and learning approaches in education and training
- Understanding assessment in education and training

Assessment method

You will produce a portfolio of evidence which is made up of various course engagement tasks. You will take part in class discussions and practical work and have individual written assignments to complete. You will be expected to spend time each week writing up and completing your course work.

You do not need to have teaching hours with this programme as you will deliver a 15-minute micro-teach to the rest of the group.

Full details of this will be discussed with the course tutor during the course.

Entry requirements

- GCSEs - grades A* - C / 9 - 4 in English and Maths or a recognised Level 2 equivalent
- You must have a subject specialism that you want to teach and ideally hold a relevant subject-specific qualification at Level 3 or higher
- **You must also attend a pre-course interview.**

What should I bring with me?

You will need to provide notepad & pen or your chosen method of note-taking
