

# **IQA ( Internal Quality Assurance) Introduction**

## **Course overview**

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Are you interested in developing your assessment skills?

Are you already a qualified assessor and want to progress into quality assurance?

This introduction will provide you with an overview of the main course and ascertain if it is the course for you.

This is a prerequisite for the main Level 4 IQA course.

## **What will I study?**

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You will be:

- inducted into The Adult College of Barking and Dagenham and be introduced to our online learning system – so that you can access classwork/assignments from home.
- provided with an overview of what being an IQA entails and ascertain your skills levels

## **Assessment method**

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You will complete an online assessment of your functional skills. Teachers will also assess your communication and written skills, through verbal and written assessment.

## **Entry requirements**

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Ideally you will hold a level 3 qualification in assessing or have worked assessing vocational qualifications, but this is not essential. You will need to hold a level 2 functional skills in Maths and English or provide evidence of working towards.

## **What should I bring with me?**

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You will need to take notes, so bring along your preferred tools, such as pen/paper or an electronic device.
