What will I study?

You will:

Assessment method

You will complete an online assessment of your functional skills. Teachers will also assess your communication and written skills, through verbal and written assessment.

Entry requirements

No specific entry requirements, however, you should ideally be involved within teaching or training and have or be working towards a minimum level 2 functional skills in Maths and English.
