Assessment method

You will be:

- required to complete a portfolio of evidence, which will be a combination of various assessment methods appropriate to the area of expertise e.g. observations, written assignments, professional discussion, presentations etc
- required to have a minimum of 2 individuals to assess within a vocational area
- observed providing feedback to a minimum of 2 individuals

Entry requirements

Ideally you will be a teacher of a vocational subject with a specialism at level 2 as a minimum. You will hold or be working towards a level 2 in functional skills in Maths and English or equivalent You will have attended the pre-requisite introduction course, prior to starting this course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes, so bring along your preferred tools, such as a pen and paper or an electronic device. An A4 ring binder will also be essential.
