

Level 3 Award in Assessing Vocationally Related Achievement

Course overview

This qualification helps to develop your assessing skills and performance in assessing vocational skills, knowledge and understanding in a workshop, classroom or other training environment.

Learning assessment skills and best practice sets you up for a career assessing workplace competence and college/workshop-based learning, knowledge and skills.

- Assess vocational skills, knowledge and understanding.

You will learn:

- Different assessment methods
- Planning assessment

- Reflective practice
- Rules, regulations, legislation, policies & codes of practice
- Equality & diversity

Assessment method

You will be required to complete a portfolio of evidence, which will be a combination of various assessment methods appropriate to the area of expertise e.g. observations, written assignments, professional discussion, presentations etc.

You will also be required to have a minimum of 2 individuals to assess within a vocational area.

You will be observed providing feedback to a minimum of 2 individuals.

Entry requirements

Ideally you will be a teacher of a vocational subject with a specialism at level 2 as a minimum.

You will hold or be working towards a level 2 in functional skills in Maths and English or equivalent

You will have attended the pre-requisite introduction course, prior to starting this course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes, so bring along your preferred tools, such as pen/paper or an electronic device.

An A4 ring binder will also be essential.
