Invigilator Training



Course overview

This is a following on course from Invigilator Training introduction.

This course will cover the practicalities of being an invigilator, ensuring that you have the tools and the knowledge to undertake invigilation activities.

What will I study?

You will:

Learn what being an invigilator entails, understand the role and what is the expectation.

Learn how to conduct an exam and the instructions which should be applied before, during and after exams, both written and computer based.

Learn how to deal with unexpected irregularities confidently and where to seek help and advice.

Assessment method

You will be assessed through various methods which may include; simulation and role play, written assessment, Q & A and discussion.

You must have attended the pre-requisite Introduction to invigilating training prior to starting this course.
