

Language of Maths

Course overview

This is a course designed for learners who wish to gain or improve their maths related language to support them alongside studying towards a maths qualifications.

What will I study?

On this course you may be introduced to topics such as:

- Working with whole numbers to add and subtract
- Multiplication and division with whole numbers
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Measurements
- Shapes and space
- Working with data

Assessment method

Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.
