

Maths GCSE Access - Blended

Course overview

The GCSE Maths Access course provides you with the opportunity to improve your maths skills and to test your abilities before attempting the qualification course. A GCSE maths qualification can help you progress in education, training and employment and make a positive contribution to your community.

What will I study?

You will study:

- Number
- Algebra
- Ratio, proportion and rates of change
- Geometry
- Measures
- Probability
- Statistics

Assessment method

Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

Entry requirements

You will need to complete a maths introduction course prior to enrolling on this course to ensure this course is at a suitable level for your needs

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder and a calculator will also be essential
