

Maths: Functional Skills for ESOL Learners

Course overview

This is a course designed for ESOL learners who wish to gain or improve their maths related language to support them whilst studying towards a maths qualifications.

What will I study?

On this course you may be introduced to topics such as:

- Working with whole numbers to add and subtract
- Multiplication and division with whole numbers
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Measurements
- Shapes and space
- Working with data

Assessment method

Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

Entry requirements

This course is open to students who are already enrolled one of the functional skills maths courses.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder and a simple calculator will also be essential
