

Maths: Functional Skills for ESOL Learners

Course overview

This is a course designed for ESOL learners who wish to gain or improve their maths related language to support them whilst studying towards a maths qualification.

What will I study?

On this course you may be introduced to topics such as:

- working with whole numbers to add and subtract
- multiplication and division with whole numbers
- fractions, decimals and percentages
- measurements
- shapes and space
- working with data

Assessment method

Online and paper-based assessments, individual work, group work and communication activities. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your own progress.

Entry requirements

This course is open to students who are already enrolled one of the functional skills maths courses.

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen and paper or an electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder and a simple calculator will also be essential.
