

English Entry 3 Induction and Access

Course overview

Start building your confidence in English with our Entry 3 Induction and Access course. This term 1 access will help you use English in everyday life, at work, and at home. You will learn in a friendly class where your tutor will guide you as a group, but you will also be encouraged to try tasks independently so you can build your skills and confidence.

You will practise reading, writing, speaking and listening through real-life activities. You will work on your own, with a partner, and in small groups. We encourage you to have a go, make mistakes and learn from them.

You will be given homework tasks each week to help you practise what you have learned and to develop good study habits.

What will I study?

On this course you will be introduced to the following topics:

- Read and understand simple sentences
- Understand the main points in a short piece of text
- Communicate information in words, phrases and simple sentences
- Use basic punctuation correctly
- Read and spell correctly words designated for Entry Level
- Identify and extract information from short statements
- Clearly express straightforward information and communicate feelings and opinions
- Make appropriate contributions to simple group discussions

Assessment method

You will take part in a range of assessments, including online and paper-based tasks, as well as individual and group activities. Throughout the course, your tutor will give you regular feedback to help you understand your progress, and you'll also develop the skills to reflect on your own learning.

Entry requirements

You will need to complete an English introduction course prior to enrolling on this course to ensure it is at a suitable level for your needs.

What should I bring with me?

You'll need to bring the essentials to help you get the most out of your learning, such as a pen and notebook or an electronic device,

Key information

This course will take place on site. In the event of unforeseen circumstances that prevent onsite delivery, sessions may take place online via Microsoft Teams.

You'll be expected to attend every session, take notes during lessons to support your understanding and keep track of key points and examples. Homework will also be part of the course, so please make sure you set aside time each week to complete tasks that reinforce your skills

After successfully completing the Access to Entry 3 course, and following guidance from your tutor, you may progress to the Entry3 English course. Alternatively, you may be directed to a different level or pathway that is better suited to your needs.
