Course overview

What will I study?

On this course you will be introduced to the following topics:

- Read and recognise different sorts of text
- Spell a range of familiar and unfamiliar words

- Write short and compound sentences
- Write in paragraphs
- Write letters, short reports and stories
- Plan and draft writing
- Proof-read your work
- Take part in discussions.

Assessment method

Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

Entry requirements

You will need to complete an English introduction course prior to enrolling on this course to ensure this course is at a suitable level for your needs.

What do I need for my class?

You will need to take notes so have your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device available. An A4 ringbinder folder will also be essential.
