

English Level 2 Induction and Access

Course overview

This course is designed to help you strengthen your English skills so you can feel more confident in everyday life, work, and study. Whether you want to improve your job prospects, support your children with their homework, or prepare for further learning, this course is a great place to start preparing for your next steps.

You will develop your reading, writing, and speaking and listening skills in a supportive and welcoming environment. Your tutor will guide you through a range of tasks, including individual work and group activities. These will help you build important skills such as making decisions, working with others, managing your time, and becoming more independent. You will also be expected to complete homework to help you practise and strengthen your learning outside of class.

What will I study?

On this course you will learn how to:

- Read critically and analytically
- Summarise your reading
- Use grammar correctly
- Plan, draft and correct letters, reports, e-mails etc.
- Use the correct language and format for different types of writing
- Proof-read your work
- Take part in discussions
- Give a short presentation

Assessment method

You will take part in a range of assessments, including online and paper-based tasks, as well as individual and group activities. Throughout the course, your tutor will give you regular feedback to help you understand your progress, and you'll also develop the skills to reflect on your own learning.

Entry requirements

You will need to complete an English introduction course prior to enrolling on this course to ensure it is at a suitable level for your needs.

What do I need for my class?

You'll need to bring the essentials to help you get the most out of your learning, such as a pen and notebook or an electronic device,

You'll be expected to attend every session, take notes during lessons to support your understanding and keep track of key points and examples. Homework will also be part of the course, so please make sure you set aside time each week to complete tasks that reinforce your skills
