- using grammar and punctuation correctly

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Online and paper-based assessments

Individual, group work and communication activities

Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

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You will need to complete an English introduction course to ensure this course is at a suitable level for your needs.
