

ESOL to Functional Skills Bridging Course

Course overview

This is a course designed for learners who have completed a level 1 ESOL qualification and want to progress to study functional skills English.

What will I study?

On this course you will be introduced to topics such as:

- Communicating clearly, effectively and imaginatively
- Organising information and ideas, using structural and grammatical features
- Recognising the role and function of non-fiction texts to inform/explain and argue/persuade
- Using imagery and descriptive techniques in writing
- Using grammar and punctuation correctly

Assessment method

Various assessment methods, including on-line and paper-based assessments, individual, group work and communication activities, and given feedback on your progress. Throughout the course you will also receive feedback from your tutor and learn the skills to self-reflect and evaluate your progress.

Entry requirements

This course is open to learners who have completed a level 1 ESOL course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to take notes so bring along your preferred tools such as pen/paper or electronic device. An A4 ringbinder folder will also be essential.
