Course overview

If you believe you would benefit from improving your English skills, whether to help you improve your job prospects, help your children with their schoolwork, or as a steppingstone to further study, this is the starting point for you.

This is an assessment session, suitable for anyone. It will assess the level you are working at and provides the first step to ensuring that you are on the right course for your current skills and needs. This session is simply about identifying your level and placing you on the right course.

What will I study?

You will:

- Complete an online assessment as well as a short writing activity designed to identify your current English skill level. This is not a test.
- Take a short screening assessment to identify any learning support you may need.
- Be introduced to the college's online learning platform so you can access classwork and homework from home.
- Discuss your goals to help us plan the best next steps for you.

Assessment method

You will complete an online initial and diagnostic assessment, along with a short writing task to help us understand your current English skills.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements.

What should I bring with me?

You may need to take notes so bring along a pen and paper or an electronic device.

This session will last up to 4 hours and will take place on site.
