

# ESOL Pre-entry / Foundation Reading and Writing

## Course overview

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Improving your English will help you to find a job, get a better job, prepare you for further study and apply for British citizenship. This course will help you develop your reading and writing skills for everyday life in the UK.

This course is for people who:

- do not have English as their first language
- have no, or very little, English
- speak English but cannot read or write in the language
- have English skills at pre-entry / foundation level

## What will I study?

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- Identifying and extending existing skills and language
- Developing communication skills
- Increasing confidence in using everyday English
- Identifying and achieving your personal learning goals
- Working towards a qualification (Foundation level)
- How to have a conversation
- Parent teacher meeting
- Buy things in a shop

## Assessment method

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- Question and answer
- Self and Learner assessment
- Paired, group, individual and online tasks
- Homework

## Entry requirements

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Entry to this course is either from the ESOL introductory course where your level of English will be determined. Learners need to meet resident criteria. To enrol on this course your Tutor must sign the enrolment form.

## What should I bring with me?

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You will need to supply your own pen and paper and will be expected to download, complete and print off work that will be sent to you electronically. You will need to have some IT skills, such as being able to save documents and work with a keyboard and mouse.
