- 1:1:1 doubling up rule for short and long words
- y to i and y to ies rules
- Silent letter patterns and rules
- Letter pattern rules (cial/tial, tion/sion/cian, ie or ei...)
- And many more

This workshop increases your confidence to spell well, to read, and to improve your vocabulary.

What will I study?

- Understand key spelling rules
- Be confident in spelling and writing
- Understand why spelling is the way it is
- Build words with prefixes and suffixes to help spelling, and reading
- Notice letter and spelling patterns
- Improve reading and vocabulary too

Assessment method

- Tutor observation
- Question and answer
- Self assessment
- Paired, group, individual, and on-line tasks
