ESOL Entry 2-3 Speaking and Listening with Citizenship

Course overview

Improving your English will help you to find a job, get a better job, access educational opportunities, apply for British citizenship and prepare for everyday life in the UK.

This course is perfect if you want the opportunity to develop your English speaking and listening skills at entry level 2-3. You will learn how to give personal information, recognise writing and its purpose, and have conversations.

This course will also assist if you are applying for indefinite leave to remain in the UK or British citizenship.

What will I study?

- Simple conversations
- Pronunciation
- How to express your views
- Listening: understanding keywords and following instructions
- Reading: recognising words and reading the alphabet
- Writing: spelling, grammar and how to make simple sentences
- How to gain a nationally recognised qualification

- Paired, group, individual and online tasks
- Homework
- Examination papers

Entry requirements

Entry to this course is from the ESOL Introduction course (where your level of English will be determined) or as progression from the lower level class. Learners need to meet the government resident eligibility criteria.

What should I bring with me?

Pen and paper (or an electronic device) and any ESOL certificates. You will be expected to download, complete, and print off work that will be sent to you electronically. You will need IT skills such as the ability to use email and work with a keyboard and mouse.
