Course overview

Improving your English will help you to find a job, get a better job, access educational opportunities, apply for British citizenship and prepare for everyday life in the UK.

At this level you already have some understanding of English, you can speak confidently and be understood. This course will help you to develop your verbal communication skills.

Entry requirements

Entry to this course is from the ESOL Introduction course (where your level of English will be determined) or as progression from the lower level class. Learners need to meet the government resident eligibility criteria.

Pen and paper (or an electronic device) and any ESOL certificates. You will be expected to download, complete, and print off work that will be sent to you electronically. You will need IT skills such as the ability to use email and work with a keyboard and mouse.
