

# ESOL Mixed Levels Introduction Course

## Course overview

This is an online ESOL course that is intended to support you in finding out your current English language level for all skills including speaking, listening, reading, and writing. You will be studying from the comfort of your own home, as all sessions will be delivered using Microsoft Teams on your PC, tablet, or smartphone. At the end of this course you will be advised on available courses and directed to the most appropriate course that suits your ability and availability.

Improving your English skills will help you enter the job market, to get a better job, help your child with homework, understand laws and customs and prepare for everyday life in the UK.

You will be studying from the comfort of your own home, as all sessions will be delivered using Microsoft Teams on your PC, tablet, or smartphone.
