

# FEML Homework Workshop for KS1 Parents

## Course overview

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This is a 1-hour long workshop to further support families of KS1 (year 1 and Year 2) to explore together different strategies to help their KS1 children with their Maths homework.

You will have the chance to ask questions about different problem-solving strategies. It will improve your understanding on how you can support your children to work out Maths problems and build their resilience and confidence.

## What will I study?

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You will:

- You can ask questions about how you can support your children with their mathematical skills development.
- You will have the opportunity to consider parts of the mathematical curriculum you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.
- You will be required to share, with the teacher, the homework you would like to explore prior to the session.

## Assessment method

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There will be no official assessment but feedback on how attending this workshop has supported you and your child will be collected regularly.

## Entry requirements

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These sessions are for all parents/carers of Key Stage one children (Years 1 and 2).

## What should I bring with me?

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You will need to share, via Teams or email, your child homework prior to each session. You will need to have access to an electronic device and bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device .
