

FEML Maths: Understanding KS2 Maths

Course overview

This course is for parents/carers of Key Stage 2 pupils (children aged 7-11). This a four (8) weeks course to support you to work towards developing your mathematical skills. It will enable you to feel more confident when helping your child to extend their reasoning and solving problems skills.

What will I study?

You will:

- Learn about Math for children aged 7-11.
- Be better equipped to support your children with their numerical development.
- Increase your understanding of Math and how it is taught in schools.
- Be encouraged to assess your own numeracy needs.
- Develop your own mathematical skills.
- Be able to increase your confidence when helping your children with Math.

Assessment method

Math' s exercises and practical activities will be set, for you to assess your understanding and show your progress. There will be no home study, but you will be encouraged to do some math with your child at home.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/ carers of KS2 pupils (children aged 7-11).

What should I bring with me?

For you to experience and appreciate the full benefit of the course, you will need to bring a pen and an exercise book to each lesson. You will also need a device (Mobile phone) to access MS Teams.
