

FEML Homework Workshop for KS2 Parents

Course overview

This 1 1/2h (one hour and a half) long workshop is to further support families to explore together different strategies to help their KS2 children with understanding how to solve their Maths homework.

You will have the chance to ask questions about different problem-solving strategies. It will improve your understanding on how you can support your children to work out Maths problems and build their resilience and confidence.

What will I study?

You will:

- You can ask questions about how you can support your children with their mathematical skills development.
- You will have the opportunity to consider parts of the mathematical curriculum you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.
- You will be required to share, with the teacher, the homework you would like to explore prior to the session.

Assessment method

There will be no official assessment but feedback on how attending this workshop has supported you and your child will be collected regularly.

Entry requirements

This taster session is for all parents/carers of Key Stage two children (Years 3 to year 6).

What should I bring with me?

We advise you to bring along the child homework, or share it via Teams or email. We also encourage all parents/carers to have access to an electronic device (mobile phone) and bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session.
