

Family Learning Maths For Parents

Course overview

The "Math for Parents" course is designed to support parents in understanding fundamental mathematical concepts and work towards developing their own mathematical skills. Through this course, parents will gain confidence in assisting their children with math-related tasks and promoting a positive attitude towards mathematics at home.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the courses and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with the course.

You will:

- Explore common challenges in math learning and how to address them.
- Work with whole numbers, fractions, decimals, and percentages, basic arithmetic operations, measurement and geometry...
- Develop a positive attitude towards math and celebrating achievements.
- How to reassure and guide children struggling with math concepts and develop resilience in math learning.
- Developing problem-solving strategies and approaches

Assessment method

You will initially be assessed when you join the course. You will also complete various in class activities and homework which will allow you and the teacher to monitor your progress on regular basis.

Entry requirements

Parents/ carers returning to education or entering new career paths that require basic mathematical skills. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with this course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for this session. If you have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device, you will be encouraged to access Teams our teaching platform. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

Key information

This course will take place on site, at your child's school. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

At the end of your course, you will be invited to attend the Family learning celebration event at the college, when you will receive progression advice and your course completion certificate.
