

FEML Maths: Keeping up with the Children

Course overview

This course is for parents and carers of pupils in key stage 2 (children aged 7-11). This a 4-week course to support you to work towards extending and developing your mathematical skills. It will enable you to feel more confident when helping your child to complete their homework. It follows on from the taster session that introduces you to the world of family maths.

What will I study?

You will:

- learn about maths for children aged 7-11.
- be better equipped to support your children with their numerical development
- develop your understanding of maths and how it is taught in schools
- be encouraged to assess your own numeracy needs
- develop your own mathematical skills.
- improve your confidence to help your children with their maths work

Assessment method

Maths exercises and practical activities will be set for you to assess your understanding and show your progress. There will be no home study, but you will be encouraged to do some maths with your child at home.
