

FEML Maths Taster: Keeping up with the Children

Course overview

This is a single taster session to give you an idea of the content of the Keeping up with the Children program. You will be introduced to the focus of the full course which will clarify the variety of techniques used by your child's school to teach maths skills in Key Stage 2 (children aged 7-11 years). You will have the chance to ask questions about the course and improve your understanding of how it will help you to support your child with their maths homework.

What will I study?

You will:

- start to work towards extending and developing your mathematical skills
- be introduced to the content of the full course.
- have an opportunity to ask questions about the different mathematical methods used in schools
- consider parts of the numeracy curriculum that you might want to revisit to refresh or develop your own math skills
- be clearer about how you can support your children with their Math's homework

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to assess your own needs and set goals for yourself to achieve during the course.

This course is for all parents and carers of children in key stage 2 (year 3 to year 6)
