Family Learning Maths KS2 SATs support for Parents

Course overview

Assessment method

There will be activities for you to complete at home with your child, to practise and apply what you have learnt.

This course is for parents/carers who wish to develop their own math skills to be able to support their KS2 children. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with the course.

You will need to bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session. You will be given the opportunity to accesss our online learning platform. For this you will need to have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device.
