

Family Learning Maths KS1 SATs support for Parents

Course overview



This course is designed for parents/carers of KS1 children. Because everything seems to be taught differently these days, it's natural for any parent or carer to want to brush up on their skills and regain confidence in their ability to support their child. This course will help you improve your mathematical skills and gain confidence in order to support your children as they prepare for their end-of-year 2 SATs.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the course and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with this course.

You will:

- Be clearer about what numeracy skills are taught in school and how you can support your children,
- Be introduced to several methods and strategies to help your children when they get ready to sit their SATs exams.
- Be able to increase your knowledge of math and develop your own mathematical skills.
- Improve your numeracy skills and increase your confidence when helping your children with their homework.

Assessment method

You will be given activities to complete in order to practise and apply what you have learned.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for this session. You will need to have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/grandparents/carers of Key Stage 1 children. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with each course.
