

Family Learning KS1 Maths Together

Course overview

This is an 8-week course for parents/carers of primary aged children in year 1 or 2. As everything seems to be taught differently now it is easy for any parent/carer to lose confidence in their ability to help their child. This course will help improve mathematical skills and build confidence to support children with Math at key stage one when they will learn to understand and make sense of mathematical ideas and how they relate to everyday life.

There will be practical and written activities, and some parts might involve your child.

What will I study?

You will:

- Be clearer about how numeracy is taught in school and how you can support your children, aged 6-7, develop their numeracy skills
- Be introduced to several methods and strategies to help your children with their numeracy development.
- Be able to increase your knowledge of math and develop your own mathematical skills.
- Improve your numeracy skills and increase your confidence when helping your children with their math's homework.

Assessment method

There will be practical and written activities for you to complete with your child. There will be no home study but you will be encouraged to complete some work with your child at home to show how you can apply what you have learnt.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers of Key Stage One children (Years 1 & 2).

What should I bring with me?

You will need to have access to an electronic device and bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session.

Key information

Where possible this course will take place on site, at the child school with social distancing measures in place. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.

Possible next steps

Following the successful completion of this course, and once you are ready you will be supported to enrol on to one of our introduction to math courses or progress onto any other relevant courses.
