

FEML Maths for Families (Taster)

Course overview

A single taster session to make you aware of the content covered in the full course Maths for Families. You will have the chance to ask questions about the program. It will improve your understanding of how you can support your children to develop their numeracy skills at an important stage in their education.

What will I study?

You will:

- start preparing to develop your mathematical skills
- be introduced to the focus of the full course which will clarify how children are taught maths in the Borough's primary schools
- have an opportunity to ask questions about how you can support your children with their numeracy development
- consider parts of the mathematical curriculum you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to start to assess your own numeracy needs and set your own learning goals.

This taster session is for all parents and carers of children in Key Stage One (years 1 and 2).
