

Family Learning KS1 Maths Taster



Course overview

This Taster to key Stage 1 (KS1) Math for families is a 2-week session to make you aware of the content of the Family Learning KS1 Maths Together.

You will have the chance to ask questions about the full programme. You will also be introduced to the Adult College and the courses you might want to access in the future. . It will improve your understanding on how you can support your children at this important stage of their schooling when they start developing their numeracy skills. You will be supported to access “Microsoft Teams” our Learning platform.

What will I study?

This taster will introduce the different areas that children will learn about in their numeracy lessons.

You will:

- Start preparing towards extending and developing your mathematical skills.
- You will be introduced to the focus of the full course which will clarify how children are taught math in the Borough’s primary schools.
- You can ask questions about how you can support your children with their numeracy development.
- You will have the opportunity to consider parts of the mathematical curriculum you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to start to assess your own numeracy needs and be able to set your own learning goals.

Entry requirements

This taster session is for all parents/carers of Key Stage One KS1 children (Years 1 & 2).

What should I bring with me?

A paper notepad and pen or any other note taking device f is essential. You will need to have access to an electronic device to access Microsoft Teams.

Where possible this course will take place on site, at your child school with social distancing measures in place. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.
