Family Learning KS1 Math Together Course overview



This course is intended for parents/caregivers of children in grades 1 or 2. Because everything appears to be taught differently these days, it is easy for any parent/carer to lose trust in their ability to help their child. This course will help you to refresh and improve your mathematical skills and gain confidence to support your child with Math. At Key Stage One, your children will start to learn how to understand and make sense of mathematical ideas and how they relate to real objects and everyday life.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the course and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with the course

You will:

- Be clearer about how numeracy is taught in school and how you can support your children, aged 5-7, develop their numeracy skills.
- Be introduced to several methods and strategies to help your children with their numeracy development.
- Be able to increase your knowledge of math and develop your own mathematical skills.
- Improve your numeracy skills and increase your confidence when helping your children with their homework.

Assessment method

There will be practical and written activities for you to complete with your child. Some schools allow the children to join some part of each session to give each parent and their child the opportunity to practise and learn together.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/grandparents/carers of Key Stage One children (Years 1 & 2). In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with the course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session. You will need to have access to a moblie phone or any other electronic device. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with onlie access.

Key information

This course will take place on site, at your child's school. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams.
