

# Family Learning Building Maths Skills For Mainstream

## Course overview

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This course aims to support parents/carers gain the foundational knowledge and skills necessary to progress onto a suitable mainstream mathematics course, to embark on their own mathematical learning journey with confidence and confidently support their children with math-related tasks. It is specifically designed for parents who are interested in progressing onto a mainstream mathematics course.

## What will I study?

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Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the courses and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with the course.

You will

- Be introduced to the topics and concepts covered in mainstream mathematics courses.
- Review common mathematical terminology and symbols.
- develop key mathematical skills needed for success in mainstream math.
- Learn effective study habits and time management techniques for math learning.

## Assessment method

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You will initially be assessed when you join the course. You will also complete various in class activities and homework which will allow you and the teacher to monitor your progress on regular basis.

## Entry requirements

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Parents/ carers returning to education or entering new career paths that require mathematical skills. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with this course.

## What should I bring with me?

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You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for this session. If you have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device, you will be encouraged to access Teams our teaching platform. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

## Key information

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This course will take place at Ripple our College Barking Site. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.
