

SATs Preparation for KS2 Families

Course overview

This is 3 Saturdays one hour and a half long workshop is to further support families to prepare together for the end of (KS2) year 6 SATs.

You will have the chance to ask questions about different problem-solving strategies. It will improve your understanding on how you can support your children to work out Maths problems and build their resilience and confidence during exams.

What will I study?

You will:

- You can ask questions about how you can support your children with applying what they have learnt to sit the exams.
- You will have the opportunity to consider parts of the mathematical curriculum you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.

Assessment method

There will be no official assessment but feedback on how attending this workshop has supported you and your child will be collected regularly.

Entry requirements

This workshop is for all parents/carers of Key Stage two children (year 6).

What should I bring with me?

We advise you to bring along the child questions, or share it via Teams or email. We also encourage all parents/carers to have access to an electronic device (mobile phone) and bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session.
