Family Learning Understanding KS2 Maths

Course overview

This course is for parents/grandparents/carers of Key Stage 2 pupils (children aged 7-11). This six (6) week-course will enable you to feel more confident when helping your child with their reasoning and solving problems skills. You will also work towards developing your own mathematical skills.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the courses and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with the course. You will:

- Learn about Math for children aged 7-11.
- Be better equipped to support your children with their numerical development.
- Increase your understanding of Math and how it is taught in schools.
- Be encouraged to assess your own numeracy needs.
- Develop your own mathematical skills.
- Be able to increase your confidence when helping your children with Math.

Assessment method

There will be learning activities for you to complete to assess your understanding and show your progress. You will be encouraged to do some math with your child at home.

Entry requirements

This course is for parents/carers of the Borough's Key Stage two (KS2) children (Years 3 to 6). In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with this course.
