

Family Learning English: Read and Write Together Taster

Course overview

This Taster to Reading and Writing Together is a single session to give you an idea of the content of the Reading and Writing Together Course.

You will have the chance to ask questions about the course and improve your understanding of how it will help you to support your children as they start developing their reading and writing skills.

What will I study?

During the taster session you will:

- be introduced to the focus of the full course which will clarify how children are taught English literacy in the Borough's primary schools
- have an opportunity to ask questions about how story-telling and traditional tales can help support reading and writing.
- consider parts of the English grammar and punctuation that you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.
- become clearer about how you can support your children develop their reading and early writing skills.

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to start to assess your own English needs and set your own learning goals.

This taster session is for all parents and carers of children in Key Stage One (years 1 and 2).
