Family Learning English: Read and Write Together Taster

Course overview

This two (2) Taster session to Reading and Writing Together is to give you an idea of the content of the Reading and Writing Together Course.

You will have the chance to ask questions about the course and improve your understanding of how it will help you to support your year 1 and 2 children as they start developing their reading and writing skills.

What will I study?

During the taster session you will:

- You will be introduced to the focus of the full course which will clarify how children are taught English literacy in the Borough's primary schools.
- You can ask questions about how story-telling and traditional tales can help support reading and writing.
- You will have the opportunity to consider parts of the English grammar and punctuation that you might want to revisit to refresh your own skills.
- You will be clearer about how you can support your children develop their reading and early writing skills.

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to start to assess your own English needs and be able to set your own learning goals.

Entry requirements

This taster session is for all parents/carers of Key Stage One children (Years 1 & 2).

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper or any other note taking device for this session. We will also support you to install MS Teams on any device to which you have access (Mobile phone, tablet, laptop).
