Family Learning English KS2 SATs Support for Parents



Course overview

This course will give you the opportunity to learn how to support your child as they prepare for their KS2 English SATs exams. You will gain a better understanding of the wide range of literacy skills, reading comprehension, writing proficiency, grammar, punctuation, and spelling knowledge required at this stage of your child's education. This will improve your understanding of how to support your children and gives you the opportunity to refresh your own literacy skills and improve your confidence when supporting your children with their English homework.

What will I study?

Please note that to have the opportunity to ask questions about the course and get a good overview of what you will be learning you must enroll on the taster associated with this course.

You will learn about:

- Inferences and how to make deductions from a range of texts and identifying the main points and themes.
- How to organise writing into paragraphs, using headings, a range of vocabulary and sentence structures.
- How to write for different purposes and audiences.
- What are homophones and common prefixes and suffixes, the use of commas, full stops, and speech marks.
- Develop grammar skills including sentence structure and the use of nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs.

Assessment method

You will have the opportunity to start to assess your own English needs and be able to set your own learning goals. You will complete practical and written activities in class to enable you to assess your progress.

Entry requirements

This course is suitable for all parents/carers of Key Stage two (KS2) children Year 5 and Year 6. In order to ask questions and understand what you will be learning, you must also complete the taster associated with each course.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper, or any other note-taking device for these sessions. You will need to have access to a mobile phone or any other electronic device. Please speak to your teacher if you have issues with online access.

Key information

This course will take place on site, at your child's school. You are advised, and will be supported, to install our learning platform Teams on your phone or any other electronic device. You will be able to access all the course resources and communicate with your teacher via Teams.
