

Family Learning: ESOL for Parents (Taster)

Course overview

This is a 2-week taster session to give you an idea about the content of the ESOL for Parents Course. You will have the chance to ask questions, also be introduced to the Adult College and the courses you might want to access in the future. You will be supported to access “Microsoft Teams” our Learning platform. You will also assess your language skills and think about your communication needs.

What will I study?

- You will be introduced to the content of the full course.
- You can ask questions about how you can develop your confidence by increasing your English communication skills.
- You will be encouraged to start Identifying some personal learning goals which you can achieve once you start the ESOL for Parents course.
- How you can gain language skills that will enable you to support your children and communicate efficiently with their teachers.

Assessment method

- During the taster sessions you will have the opportunity to assess your own needs and set goals for you to achieve during the course.

Entry requirements

This taster is for parents/carers, of primary school children, who have English as an additional language.

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, a notepad or any other note taking device. You will also need a device (Mobile phone) to access MS Teams.

Key information

Where possible this course will take place on site at your child's school with social distancing measures in place. In the event of a lockdown, the course will take place online via MS Teams.
