

Wider Family Learning: Saturday Science I – Kitchen Science Taster

Course overview

Would you like some fun and educational activities to do with your children? Have you thought about science? This session will introduce you and your child to our Kitchen Science course. Use things from your kitchen cupboards to have great fun with science, with us and at home.

What will I study?

You will:

- Be able to use simple and safe household chemicals to run your own experiments
- Learn how to be safe when experimenting
- Do a chromatography experiment
- Have instructions to take home to experiment further and wow the family

Assessment method

- Practical and written activities.

Entry requirements

For parents and children at Key Stage 1 or 2

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper and a folder to each lesson.
An apron, old shirt/T-shirt from a grown-up or messy play cloths are strongly recommended.
You may also wish to take photos of your child's experiment.
