

Wider Family Learning: Making Super Bubbles

Course overview

We all love blowing bubbles. In this session will create supersized bubbles and learn about why we can make them so big. This session will introduce you and your child to fun and safe science experiments. We will use things that can be found in your household and kitchen cupboards to have great fun with science, with us and then with you at home.

What will I study?

You will:

- Learn how to be safe when experimenting
- Be able to use simple and safe household chemicals to run your own experiments
- Conduct a couple of great science experiments with different sized bubbles and surface tension
- Have instructions to take home to experiment further and wow the family

Assessment method

- Practical and written activities.

Entry requirements

For families with children at Key Stage 1 or 2

What should I bring with me?

You will need to bring a pen, paper and a folder to each lesson.
An apron, old shirt/T-shirt from a grown-up or messy play clothes are strongly recommended.
You may also wish to take photos of your child's experiment.
